

Important Points and Requests Related to Examinations to be Held in August 2022

The Graduate School of Engineering will implement the following measures in order to prevent the potential spread of COVID-19 at the examination site, as well as to ensure the safety of all applicants and persons involved in the examinations. We ask for your understanding and cooperation.

Please note that the measures may change depending on any developments in the COVID-19 situation. We will post any changes on the Graduate School of Engineering's website, so please regularly check the website leading up to the day of the examinations.

1. Basic policies

As indicated in the Application Guidelines, entrance examinations for the Master's Program will be held in person (written and oral examinations), with thorough infection prevention measures in place.

However, **some departments will hold the oral examination remotely** for the Master's Program entrance examinations. Applicants for whom this is applicable will be notified of the details separately.

For the Doctoral Program entrance examinations, applicants will be notified of the details of the procedures, etc. separately by their respective departments.

Please note that if it is determined that examinations cannot be held as planned for reasons such as entry to the University being prohibited due to the spread of COVID-19 or a large-scale outbreak occurring at the University, the examination date may be changed, cancelled, or switched to an online examination to be held remotely. In case of such a situation, please be sure to have a sufficient and stable internet connection as well as a computer with a microphone and webcam at home.

2 Applicants who cannot take the examination

Please note that persons who fall under any of the following cannot take the examination.

- (1) Persons who were diagnosed with COVID-19 and have not been determined by a doctor as having recovered by the date of the examination.
- (2) Persons who are identified by the health center, etc. as a close contact right before the examination.
- (3) Persons who have symptoms such as a fever and a cough, and have a fever of 37.5

degrees or higher when measured on the day of the examination.

(4) Persons who have any symptoms indicated on the symptom check list in the "Medical Observation Sheet" prescribed by the Graduate School of Engineering, on the day of the examination.

(5) Any other persons who have symptoms such as a fever and a cough on the day of the examination and are determined by the examination main office that they are unable to take the examination.

* Note: The determination for (5) will be made based on the diagnosis and confirmation made by the doctors, etc. at Nagoya University.

3. Make-up examinations

As an alternative measure for applicants who were unable to take the examination due to falling under any of (1) to (5) from the "2. Applicants who cannot take the examination" above, we will offer make-up examinations if they wish to take it, so please apply for a make-up examination if you would like to do so.

(1) Application units for make-up examinations

For both the Master's Program and Doctoral Program, the "application unit for make-up examinations" due to feeling sick or unwell on the day of the examination is an examination day per unit.

(2) Application method

4. Requests to all applicants

[Procedures leading up to examination day]

(1) Taking care of your health

- In the week leading up to the examination dates and after (August 16 - September 2), please measure your temperature every morning and check for any changes in your physical condition by referring to the "Medical Observation Sheet" (posted on the Graduate School of Engineering website).
- Please make the effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and take care of your own health, by washing and disinfecting your hands, observing coughing etiquette such as wearing a mask, maintaining physical distance from others, avoiding the 3 C's, and avoiding going to congested places as much as possible, etc.
- If you show any symptoms such as a fever or a cough from around 2 weeks prior to the examination, please visit a medical institution and receive appropriate treatment ahead of time. Also, if you are diagnosed with COVID-19 or it is suspected that you may have it, please contact the Admission Section of the Student Affairs Division immediately regardless of whether you will apply for a

make-up examination or not.

(2) Applying for a make-up examination

- If you are eligible to take a make-up examination due to being diagnosed with COVID-19 etc., please follow the required application procedures within the application period.

(3) Applicants who have difficulty wearing a mask

- If it is difficult for you to wear a mask for reasons such as hypersensitivity, please make a phone call to the Admission Section of the Student Affairs Division by July 19 (Tue), 2022, and consult with them ahead of time. Please note that applicants who have difficulty wearing a mask but did not have a consultation by the deadline will not be permitted to take the examination without wearing a mask.

(4) Registering to the Applicant Information Form

- In the event where the examination date, selection method, etc. are suddenly changed due to the COVID-19 situation, we may contact the relevant applicants, so we ask that everybody register their emergency contact information.

* Students enrolled at Nagoya University are also required to register.

[On Examination Day]

(1) Temperature check on the morning of the examination

- On the morning of the day of the examination, please measure your temperature and check whether there is any change in your physical condition by referring to the "Medical Observation Sheet".

If any of the symptoms on the Medical Observation Sheet below applies to you, you will be unable to take the examination, and will instead be urged to visit a medical institution. In this case, you will be eligible to apply for a make-up examination, so please follow the required application procedures within the application period.

● Medical Observation Sheet Checklist Items

Severe fatigue	Diarrhea
Difficulty breathing (shortness of breath)	Nausea
Coughing	Loss of smell or taste
Sore throat/runny nose	

- You must bring your "Medical Observation Sheet" with you on the day of the examination. If we find that you are feeling unwell, we will check the recorded information on the "Medical Observation Sheet".

(Note) You are not required to submit your "Medical Observation Sheet" at the examination site.

(2) For those who are feeling unwell

- a) If you develop symptoms such as a fever or a cough after arriving at the

examination site, a doctor or medical staff will check your symptoms based on the "Health Status Checklist" at a resting room, etc., and in some cases, we may ask you to apply for a make-up examination.

If you are feeling unwell on the day of the examination and you are already on campus, please inform the exam supervisor or the person in charge of the examination site ahead of the examination of your physical conditions, and follow their instructions.

- b) During the examination, if the exam supervisor determines that an applicant is affecting other applicants for reasons such as frequent severe coughing, we may ask that applicant to stop taking the examination and move to a resting room, etc. After checking that applicant's symptoms, we may ask that applicant to apply for a make-up examination. However, in this case, the applicant cannot apply for a make-up examination for that day's examination.
- c) If you are identified as a COVID-19 close contact during the examination period, please contact the Admission Section of the Student Affairs Division immediately.

***Important Notes**

- **We will not have a separate room for applicants who are feeling unwell** on the day of the examination.
- **There will be no extra time given for the examination** in any of the following cases:
 - (1) If you feel unwell during the examination
 - (2) If you report that you feel unwell before the start of the examination of that day, and the doctor determines that you are able to take the examination on that day (if you take the main examination without applying for a make-up examination)
 - (3) If you have a severe cough during the examination, and the exam supervisor stops you from taking the examination due to their decision that you may affect the other applicants

(3) Others

- Regardless of whether you have any symptoms or not, each applicant must bring a mask (including a spare mask), and are to always wear to ensure coverage of both nose and mouth at the examination site. However, the exam supervisor may ask you to remove your mask temporarily when verifying your photograph to confirm your identity. Please note that you cannot take the examination while wearing a face shield or mouth shield. If for some reason you are unable to wear a mask, you must consult with us ahead of time. (Refer to "4-(3) Applicants who have difficulty wearing a mask" on page 3)
- During break time, please refrain from touching or having conversations with others as much as possible, and do not sit in any seat except your own.
- During breaks, we ask for your cooperation in avoiding using crowded restrooms.

- In addition, please thoroughly wash your hands after using the restroom.
- Persons involved in the examination including the exam supervisor, etc. will also wear a mask. If it is difficult to understand the supervisor's instructions, please let them know.
 - We will place bottles of alcohol-based hand sanitizer at the examination site. Please be sure to disinfect your hands each time you enter/exit the examination room.
 - If for some reason you have difficulty using alcohol-based hand sanitizer, please prepare an alternative for yourself and disinfect your hands and fingers.
 - On the day of the examination, we may open windows or take other actions to ventilate the examination room. Please wear season-appropriate clothing.

[After Finishing the Examination]

- When leaving the examination room, please follow the instructions of the exam supervisor.
- Do not dispose of your mask at the examination site.
- After finishing the examination, please ensure that you go straight home if possible, and wash your hands and face after returning home.
- If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within one week of finishing the examination, please contact the Admission Section of the Student Affairs Division.
