

# Precautions for the Graduate School of Engineering Entrance Examination

In the entrance examination of the Graduate School of Engineering, Nagoya University, the use of the following electronic devices is prohibited unless otherwise instructed by your department/program.

**Mobile phones, personal computers, smartphones, wearable devices (e.g. smartwatches and smart glasses), earphones, IC recorders, and similar electronic devices.**

These devices may not be used for any purpose, including as a watch or for taking notes. If you bring any of these devices into the examination room, you must disable any alarms, turn off the power, and store them in your bag or other belongings.

**Use of any electronic device during the examination will be regarded as misconduct. Wearing or holding such a device during the examination may also be deemed misconduct.**

If an examinee commits misconduct, the examinee will be instructed to stop the examination immediately and leave the examination room. The examinee will not be permitted to take any subsequent examinations.

In addition, all results of examinations already taken will be invalidated.

Depending on the circumstances, the University may take further action, including reporting the matter to the police.
